

MIRA MESA PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL ADMISSION AGREEMENT

I/We understand that our child has been enrolled in MMPP for the 2024-2025 School Year. The terms of enrollment are, as follows:

TUITION POLICY

- All tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month (August – April), whether or not your child is present at school; this includes holidays, sick days, and emergency unexpected closures.
• Your tuition will be past due if not paid by the 5th of each month. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed.
• Any check returned to the school for insufficient funds will be served with a \$25 fee in addition to any bank fees.
• Multiple instances of returned checks could result in the Preschool requiring payment by money order or cash.
• Late payments can result in suspended care from the school.
• Annual fees are nonrefundable and payable by check, cash, or Zelle. To secure placement for the 2024 – 2025 school year, the following fees are due upon enrollment: registration (\$100) and supply (\$150). 1 month tuition is due by August 1, 2024.

ENROLLMENT TERMINATION OR DECREASING DAYS BY CHANGING SCHEDULE

The Preschool may terminate this Admission Agreement if the parents fail to comply with any of its policies or if the school is unable to meet the needs of the child. If a parent wishes to withdraw a child from the school or decrease days by changing schedule, a 30-DAY advance written notice is required. Withdrawal and schedule change forms are available in the office.

VACATION POLICY

In order to retain your child’s place in a classroom, full tuition must be paid during all vacations. If you wish to withdraw your child from the school, his/her name will be placed on our waiting list. Please contact the office when you return, to check re-enrollment status.

ACCIDENTS AND INJURY

Every effort is made to ensure safety for all children. In consideration of the risks involved to participate at MMPP, all parties agree to hold harmless. All injuries are attended to, cleaned, and ice applied when necessary. Our staff are instructed to send an ‘Ouch Report’ home if any accident requires first aid. Staff will take any or all of the following steps in the event of an accident or illness to obtain emergency medical care if warranted.

- 1. Attempt to contact a parent or guardian
2. Attempt to contact parent through any of the persons listed on the emergency information form you have completed for us.
3. If we are unable to contact you, we will:
A. Call 911.
B. Have child taken to an emergency hospital in the company of a staff member.

HANDBOOK

The Preschool Handbook is available at mmpreschool.org to explain all school policies and procedures. An acknowledgement receipt is required.

MEDICATION

Mira Mesa Presbyterian Preschool does NOT dispense medication. However, we will keep medication on site for emergency allergic reactions and asthma. Additional paperwork is required for the use of emergency medication.

LICENSING

State Licensing has the authority to inspect the facility and interview children in our care.

SCHOOL ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Please be prompt in bringing your child to school (8:30 am) and picking up at the end of the session (12:30 pm). Parents/Guardians are responsible for signing in/out each day with full legal signature. Children arriving after 8:45 am must enter the school through the front office. A late fee will be charged for children consistently picked up after 12:30 pm. The late fee is \$10 for the first 15 minutes (or any portion thereof) and \$1 per minute thereafter. A child who is routinely picked up late gives MMPP the option to suspend care.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

The Preschool will observe the following holidays: Veterans Day, Thanksgiving (5 days), Christmas Break (11 days), Martin Luther King Day, Lincoln and Washington’s Birthdays (2 days), Spring Break (5 days), Good Friday and Memorial Day. Twice each year the Preschool will be closed to provide time for parent-teacher conferences. The Preschool will also be closed for staff professional growth/training (2 days).

TUITION/PAYMENT INFORMATION

Tuition is based on a 9-month school year and is divided into nine equal payments regardless of school days, holidays or child's absences. A \$25 late fee will be added to a balance that is 5 days past due. If tuition is more than 10 days past due, a child will not be allowed to continue in the program until payment is received. **A ONE month paid notice is required if you withdraw your child at any time.**

- 1st day of month 2 – 1 month tuition due
- 15th day of month 2 – ½ month tuition due
